

## Horses on Beach

### Horse riding on Goolwa beach

Goolwa Beach offers horse enthusiasts the unique opportunity to ride on part of the Fleurieu Peninsula's most pristine coastline.

It is important that horse owners are aware of both the changing landscape of Goolwa Beach and Council's conditions associated with the riding of horses on this stretch of land.

Horses are only permitted to be exercised on the area of Goolwa Beach described in this permit. Please keep our beach beautiful, clean and safe by following the conditions of this permit.

Please be advised that this is a public road and a shared space, please respect the rights of all other beach users, as this section of beach is also available to the public, 4WD Vehicles and dogs.

#### This form is your permit to ride on Goolwa Beach

All conditions of this permit must be met. You need to carry this permit with you at all times whilst riding on Goolwa Beach. You may be required to present this permit to a Council Officer upon request.



- A - Horse float parking
- B - Remove horse manure
- C - Beach access entrance
- D - East only, from this sign



### Conditions

- Access to and from Goolwa Beach is via the four wheel drive track only as sign posted.
- Riders only use the section of Goolwa Beach to the East of the Goolwa Beach car park towards the Murray Mouth.
- That all horse floats be parked on the unsealed section of the car park.
- No horses or riders encroach into the sand dunes, which are a Conservation area.
- 24 hour access to the beach is permitted in accordance with the above conditions.
- Generally, horses should be ridden at a safe speed at all times and in a manner that does not endanger the safety of any person in the area.
- Horse riders should not unduly interfere with the peace, comfort or convenience of other users of the foreshore.
- Horses should be ridden at walking pace within 50m of all other beach users.
- As conditions on Goolwa Beach may be hazardous due to sand dredging work at the Murray Mouth, access for vehicles and horses may be restricted to the area between the Beach Road car park and the barrier denoting the exclusion zone.
- Carrying of this permit indicates that you understand and will adhere to all the conditions stipulated on this form.
- Parking is between the horse trailer sign located at the rear of the Goolwa Beach car park.
- **All manure and rubbish must be collected and taken with you and NOT placed in the conservation park adjoining the parking area.**
- Access from the car park onto Goolwa Beach is via the four wheel drive track only.

Goolwa Beach is situated on the end of 'Beach Road' Goolwa.

Beach Road is accessible via the intersection with Hutchinson Road and the Goolwa to Victor Harbor Road.

Horse float parking is clearly marked on your right as you enter the carpark.
