Public Toilet Refurbishment Horseshoe Bay, Port Elliot

7 March 2023



The public amenities located behind The Port Elliot Bowling Club at Horseshoe Bay are receiving an upgrade.

Horseshoe Bay is covered by a local heritage overlay and in alignment with community sentiment, the facility is suitable to undergo refurbishment with current facilities rather than full replacement.

Refurbishment works of the public toilets will commence after the public school holidays in April 2023 with anticipated completion in June 2023. Temporary exclusion zones during the works will maintain pedestrian flow, ensure public safety, and secure the work site.

Design elements will include environmentally sustainable systems and infrastructure including energy efficient appliances and water saving products.

Essential elements of this project include external painting of walls and exposed trusses, roof and gutter replacement, lighting upgrade, path upgrades, and internal refurbishment of fittings and tiles including appliance upgrade.

Total project budget of \$280K will be funded by Alexandrina Council.

“It’s great to see these toilets that have been part of the Horseshoe Bay landscape can be upgraded and refurbished to meet environmental and accessibility standards.”

During the works period, visitors to Horseshoe Bay won’t be without facilities. The public toilets on Commodore Reserve are open.
