Strathalbyn streetscape Stage 1 commences

8 December 2020

Strathalbyn celebrates as stage one of the Streetscape Revitalisation Project commences. Council contractor's, Axiom, will begin works on Monday 7 December on Albyn Terrace for this much anticipated project to beautify and connect the Strathalbyn town centre.

The Albyn Terrace streetscape elements will re-align the three-way intersection between Sunter Street, Albyn Terrace, and Rankine Street and include landscaping, stormwater, underground services, kerbs and footpaths for the area.

Construction on the intersection elements will be completed by February and footpaths and shop entrances will remain accessible to the public for the majority of the project works with interruptions kept to a minimum. Over the Christmas break the site will be safe and accessible to businesses and adjoining areas. The short construction period of three months aims to restore car parking in the area as quickly as possible.

Works to connect and beautify the area around the Saint Andrews Church will commence in January after the Christmas break and will include new street trees and garden beds, a feature stone wall, new footpaths and crossing points, plus a turfed area opposite the Soldiers Memorial Gardens.

All stage one elements, including Sunter Street area around Saint Andrews Church, are expected to be completed by 31 March 2021.

Council are pleased to see works commence for a revitalised Strathalbyn town centre that will transform parts of the current road network space into usable, safe and landscaped public spaces.
