NOTE: The mature height of planted vegetation must not exceed 1 meter within 30 metres of road intersections

Council requires that the choice of species is site specific, in order to improve:

- · Service provision and infrastructure maintenance.
- · Bushfire prevention.
- · Conservation of local indigenous vegetation and/or
- · Conservation of cultural and visual amenity.

Unless otherwise specified, Council requires that indigenous plant species, propagated from locally sourced material, is to be used in revegetation works.
