Walk & Explore

River Angas Walkway Map E2

A family friendly walk through Strathalbyn following the picturesque Angas River. Signage along the way will highlight the significance of the river and its wildlife. Some great locations along the way for a picnic and bird watching. Map via Strathalbyn Visitor Information Centre.

Location: Soldiers Memorial Gardens, Strathalbyn

Mount Compass Wetlands Map B4

A fascinating wetland boardwalk featuring rare and endangered plant/bird species and sculptures from the Adelaide Hills Sculpture Symposium.

Location: Cnr Victor Harbor Road & Nangkita Road, Mount Compass

Currency Creek Waterfall Walk Map C5

Enjoy a wander along Currency Creek on this family friendly walk, finishing at a charming rock pool and small waterfall.

Location: Lions Park Picnic Area, Alexandrina Road, Currency Creek

Nurragi Conservation Reserve Map F4

Follow the Nurragi Walking Trail along a former railway corridor that now has a vital function in the conservation of native plants and animals. The 12.4km linear trail starts at Sandergrove and finishes in Milang and has a number of features of interest along the way.

Location: Tucker Road, Sandergrove

Goolwa Boardwalk Map D6

Follow the 170m boardwalk to the lookout viewing platform to admire the spectacular views along the Alexandrina coastline. The first half of the boardwalk is wheelchair accessible.

Location: Beach Road, Goolwa Beach

Jekejere Park Map D6

The design of this park reflects Ngarrindjeri culture and includes native foods and medicine plants. Follow a short meandering pathway that journeys through stories of the past using interpretive signage and artworks.

Location: Goolwa Terrace, Goolwa Wharf Precinct

Alexandrina Bird Trail

The region plays host to a diverse range of birdlife, from migratory waders through to protected and endangered species. A series of connected trails around the region showcases great bird viewing locations in the area.

Harbourmasters Walking Trail Map C6

A 1.8km circuit hike between Horseshoe Bay and Knights Beach. The trail follows a cobblestone path around the headland of Freemans Knob and takes in several beautiful beaches, rock formations, historic gardens and stunning coastal views.

Location: The Strand, Port Elliot

Ride & Skate

Goolwa Skate Park and Pump Track Map D6

The Goolwa Skate Park precinct offers a concrete skate park featuring an open bowl, spine, and small halfpipe, BMX track and a brand new asphalt pump track. Great for beginner and intermediate skaters, BMX riders and scooters. Sheltered smart bench available.

Location: Glendale Grove, Goolwa

Mount Compass Recreation Park Map B4

The Mount Compass Recreation Park incorporates a state of the art skate park and BMX track. Above the skate park there is a sheltered spectator viewing area and picnic table. The park also offers a nature play area with basket swing, slide and sandpit.

Location: Waye Court, Mount Compass

Strathalbyn Skate Park Map E2

Strathalbyn Skate Park has a great bowl and street area which contains a rail, banks, quarters, ledges and manual pads. Suitable for all skating abilities. Grassed area, seating and shelter.

Location: North Parade, Strathalbyn

Encounter Bikeway Map B7-D6

A great way for the whole family to enjoy a bike ride. Experience 30km of scenic bikeway between Goolwa and Victor Harbor, ride the whole way or opt for a shorter, easier ride. Suitable for bikes, trikes, scooters and walkers of all ages and levels of fitness. Wheelchair accessible.

Location: Laffin Point, Goolwa to Rosetta Head, Encounter Bay

Swim

Strathalbyn Community Swimming Pool Map E2

Outdoor swimming pool set in picturesque gardens overlooking the River Angas. Toddler pool and 50m pool, plus inflatable sessions during weekends and school holidays. Open October-April.

Indoor aquatic centre, water depths to suit all ages and abilities, water play features plus outdoor splash park!

Parks & Places

Bullock Hill Conservation Park **Map D3**

Choose between the Eucalypt Hike (4.3km), Heathland Hike (2.9km) or Native Grasses Hike (4km) and explore the grasslands and gum trees.

Location: Haines Road, Ashbourne



Cox Scrub Conservation Park **Map C3**

Follow the Emu Wren Hike (8.5km), Stringybark Hike (4km) or Quarry Hike (3.5km) trails through this undulating bushland.

Location: Bull Creek Road, Ashbourne



Kyeema Conservation Park **Map C3**

Follow the Mulurus Hike (1.25km) or Myrtacee Hike (5km) to explore this diverse and densely vegetated park.

Location: Woodgate Hill Road, Kyeema



Mount Magnificent Conservation Park **Map C3**

Follow the Heysen Trail through the forest up to the summit of Mount Magnificent, with spectacular views of the surrounding countryside. A moderate level of fitness is required.

Location: Blackfellow's Creek Road, Mount Magnificent



Scott Conservation Park **Map C4**

A choice of loop walking trails wind through blue and pink gum woodlands.

Location: Gould Road, Currency Creek



Ratalang-Basham Beach Conservation Park **Map C6**

Featuring a beautiful beach, historical buildings and walking trails, Ratalang-Basham Beach Conservation Park links Middleton and Port Elliot along the foreshore. The Encounter Bikeway runs through this pretty park.

Location: Basham Beach Road, Port Elliot



Kuitpo Forest **Map C2**

Walking, cycling and horse riding are all popular activities in Kuitpo Forest. The Heysen and Kidman Trails both pass through the forest and a number of multi-use trails wind their way through the trees. For more information on trails, accommodation and other facilities contact the Kuitpo Forest Information Centre or visit the Forestry SA website.
