## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE OVERDIMENSIONAL VEHICLE CERTIFICATE

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS AS ANY BREACH OF THE CONDITIONS LISTED WILL HAVE YOUR PERMIT REVOKED

This permit is subject to the following conditions:

1. The operator MUST apply to the *Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure* Permit Section for a permit to operate on all roads.

2. Council authorised vehicle dimension limits to be adhered to.
3. Council authorised roads only to be used.
4. Transportation is to be carried out in daylight hours.
5. Any damage to Alexandrina Council infrastructure resulting from access by the Applicant's vehicle(s) will be repaired at the Applicant's expense.
6. It is the responsibility of the Applicant to ensure that any road signage or infrastructure to be temporarily removed for access must be reinstated immediately after the transport operation. Failure or delays causing any traffic or pedestrian incidents will be the responsibility of the applicant and may result in fines.
7. The Applicant's vehicle(s) must be registered in the Company's name.
8. The Applicant agrees to indemnify and keep indemnified the Alexandrina Council against all actions, costs, claims, damages, or charges resulting from any act, omission or failure by the Applicant to comply with these Conditions of Overdimensional Vehicle Access or any Special Conditions contained herein.
9. Drivers / Operators must observe and avoid all horizontal, vertical and overhead obstructions.
10. The issuing of this Overdimensional Vehicle Access Certificate does not provide exemptions to exceed mass on designated load limits on bridges, culverts, roads or other infrastructure with load limits.
11. In order to transport a building with fibre cement cladding and constructed prior to 1990, evidence of testing confirming that no materials in the building contain asbestos must be provided. Samples for testing must be collected and analysed by an independent laboratory that is approved by Safe Work SA.
12. For transportable buildings a Development Application must be approved by Council's Planning & Development Division prior to transportation being approved.
13. No native vegetation (including grasses, shrubs, trees, dead trees and timber shall be removed without written consent from the Native Vegetation Council (NVC).
