

Ninth and Tenth Schedule Permits

Alexandrina Council does not issue permits for the purpose of burning off or use of fire to clear land during the fire danger season, unless under special circumstances (in the opinion of the Bushfire Prevention Officer).

If you require a Ninth schedule permit to burn or do hot works of any kind during the fire danger season you must apply, giving reasonable notice, prior to the date you wish to commence work.

Tenth schedules are only issued on a Total Fire Ban day for emergency works only, special cases may be given a permit based on their merits.

A Ninth Schedule permit:

- Will require an inspection prior to being issued
- Is issued at the discretion of the Authorised Fire Prevention Officer
- Is not valid on days declared a total fire ban

A Tenth Schedule Permit:

- Is only valid on days declared a total fire ban
- Will require an inspection prior to being issued
- Is issued at the discretion of the Authorised Fire Prevention Officer
